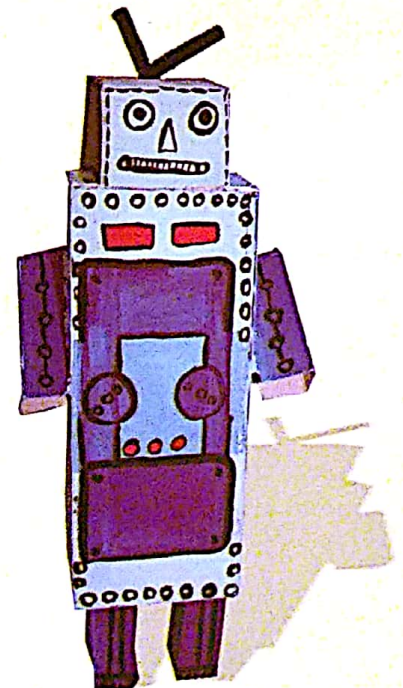
4 Make a Recycle Robot.

- decorating materials

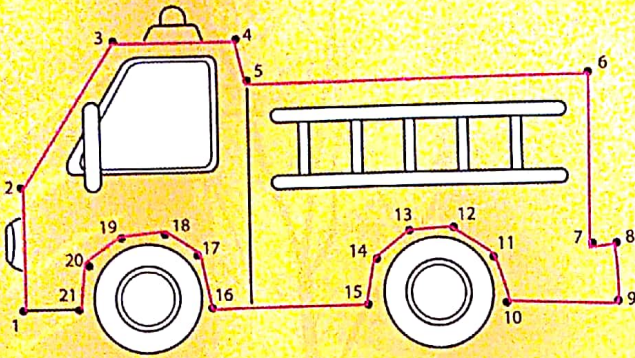
Instructions
